Dear Friends,

If you are anything like me, over the years, you've probably made your share of New Year's resolutions. Looked at yourself and your life and decided on certain aspects that you would like to change, and that you were ready to resolve in yourself to change. It's a new year with no mistakes in it, (yet), and a good time to take your life in new directions.

But can we, in and of ourselves, really take our lives in new directions?

One of the foundations of our Christian faith is that just as our cells are created by the Lord to grow in a certain sequence to create our physical bodies, so too is the Lord the creator and maker of our spiritual bodies. We do not overcome our temptations on our own, we do not change on our own, we submit ourselves to the Lord that he may overcome these temptations and make these changes within us.

A person must fight against false rationalizations and cravings when in temptation; *but it is really the Lord who fights, through the angels who are adjoined to each person.* As soon as the falsities are separated, and as it were dispersed, by these combats, the person is prepared to receive the truths of faith. Thus is it with the reformation or regeneration of the spiritual person. (Emanuel Swedenborg, Heavenly Secrets, n. 653)

While we may believe the best way to fulfill our New Year's resolutions is through the strength of our will power, our faith would tell us otherwise. Our faith

would tell us that the only way we can truly turn our lives in a new direction, make real and lasting change, is with the help and grace and strength of the Lord. That whether we wish to lose weight, become more patient with our spouse, quit smoking, improve our grades, be more generous, make a career change, whatever changes we yearn for, we step into these changes, not through pushing and forcing ourselves, but through surrender to the Lord.

I'm going to use losing weight and becoming more active and healthy as an example (because it is a resolution near and dear to my heart).

Why is it that as December 31st rolls around, and I look at all the days of too much couch sitting and too much sweet eating through the previous year, could I think that somehow I have the skills come January 1st to turn that all around and live a whole new life where going to the gym and eating 8 servings of vegetables every day comes easily! It's kind of a ridiculous belief (that I have fallen prone to many a year, only to be disappointed come February). The truth is we don't have the skills, ability, or freedom to live that new healthy life style. If we did, we'd be doing it! But we can have all of it.

To wish for change is first to admit that how we have been living is not working for us and that somehow we have not had the skills or ability or freedom up to this point to live as we truly wish to. We cannot snap our fingers and magically find this new ability and freedom within ourselves but the Lord can give them to us. The Lord can fill us up with more confidence, strength, and motivation than we can imagine! All we need do is ask.
