Claudia Graves has been admitted to Maine Medical Center. Our thoughts and prayers are with her.

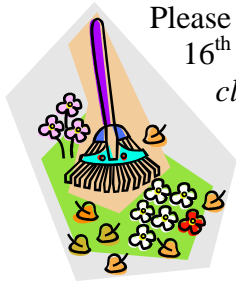

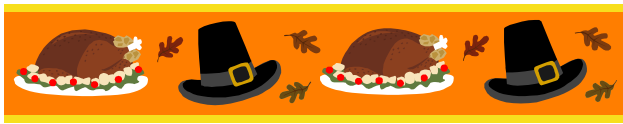
